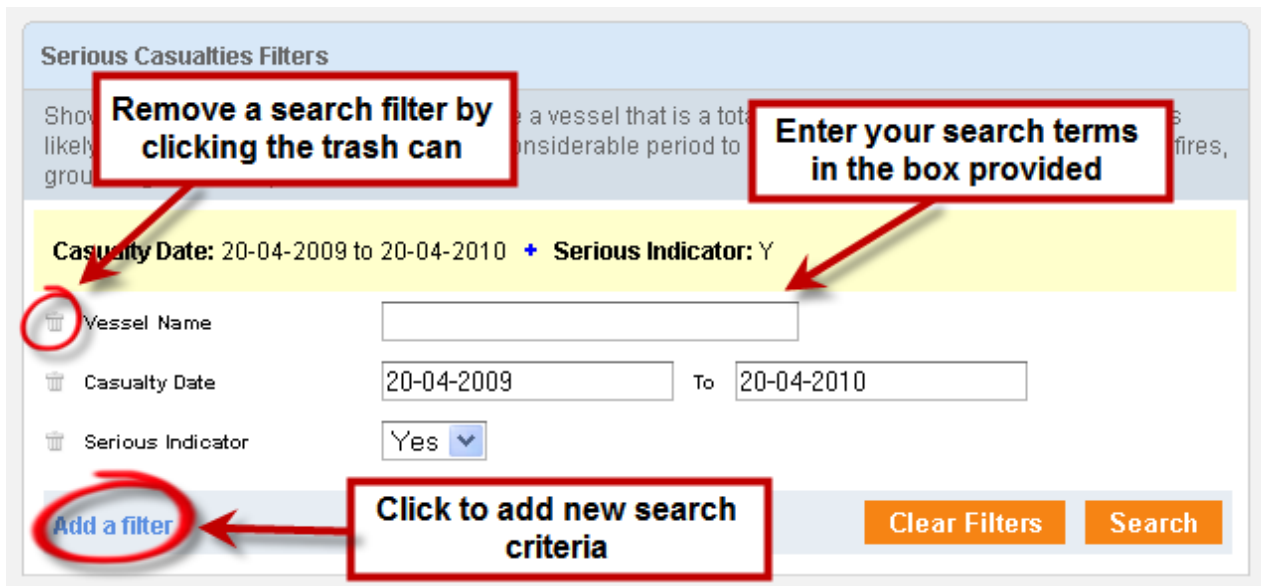
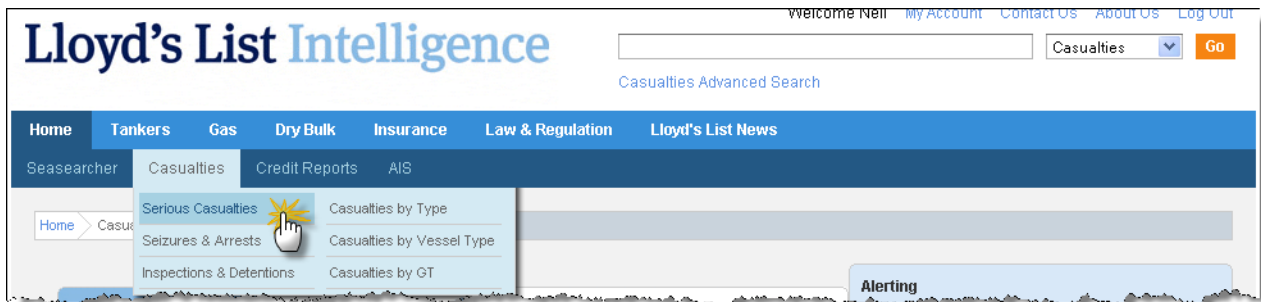

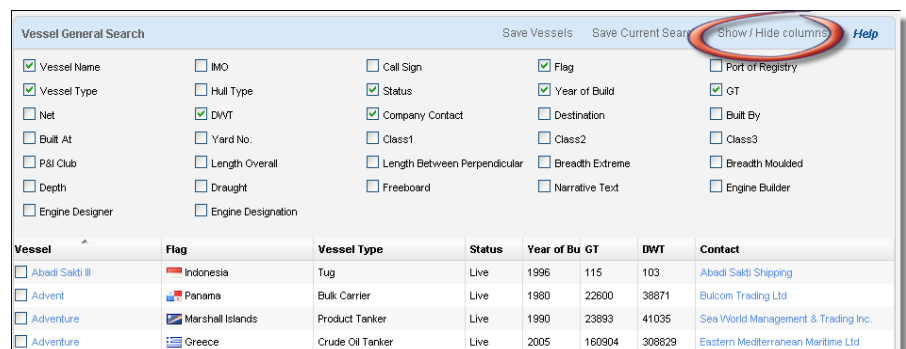
a. Viewing serious casualties

- From the Insurance tab, hover over Casualties and then click *Serious Casualties*.



- To customise the information you see in the search results click the *'Show/Hide columns'* at the top right of the search results box.

- Check the box next to the information you need to see, or uncheck the box to remove this information from view.

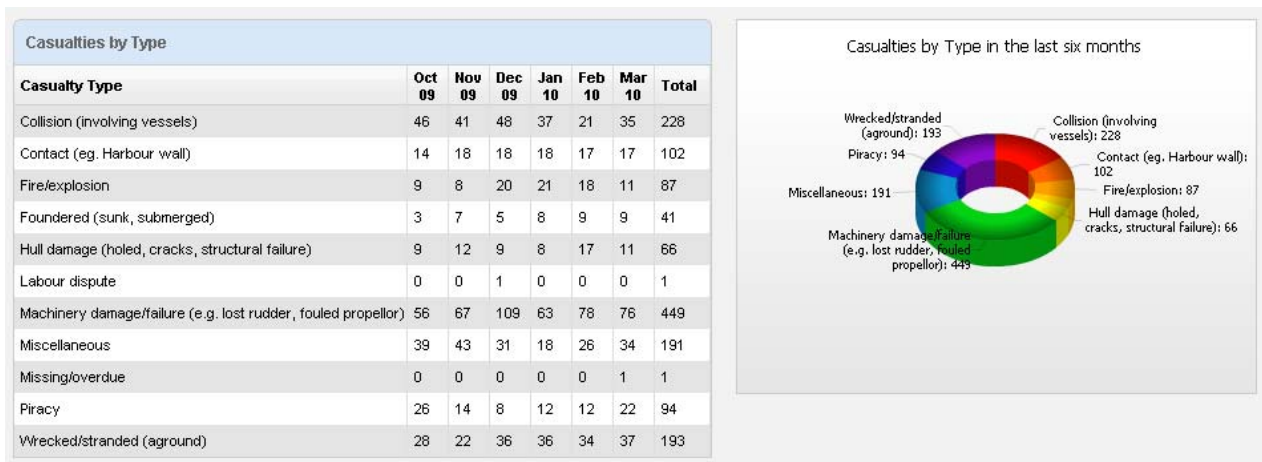

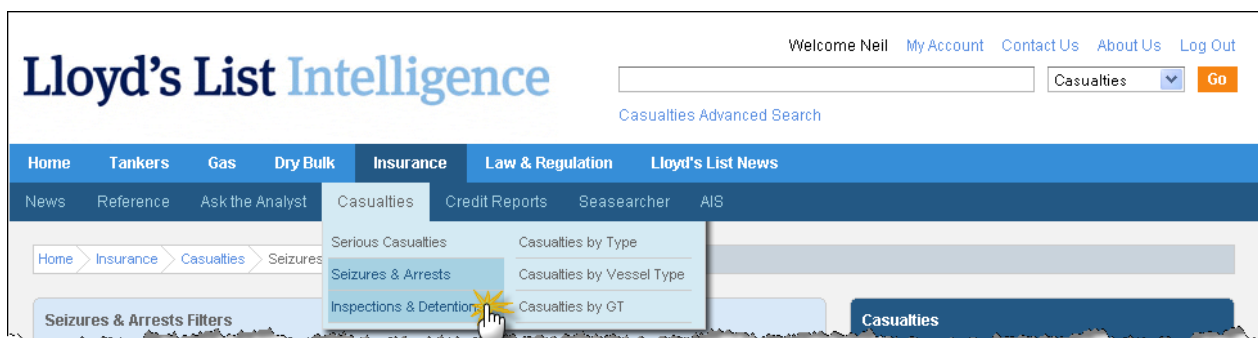

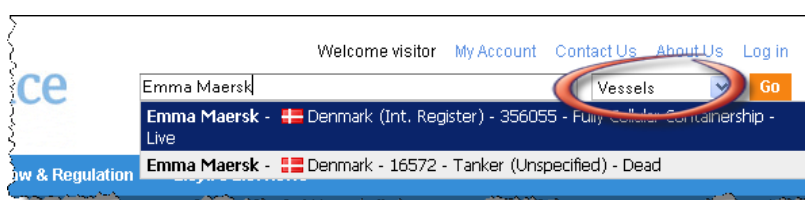
a. Quick Search

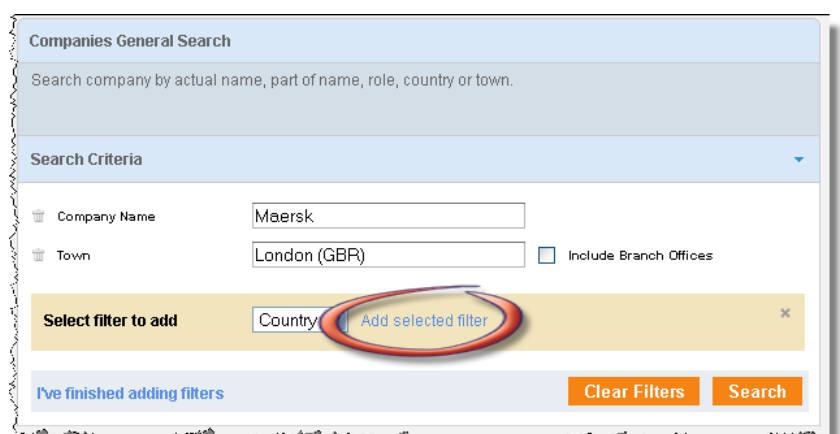
